

Chemistry Class Guidelines

- 1. Respect other people and their property.**
Be respectful and polite to others including the teacher, classmates, class visitors and substitute teachers.

- 5. Raise your hand before talking in class.**
Unless we are engaged in group activities; tests or quizzes; or individual work, only one person (either the teacher or a student) should be speaking at a time.
- 6. Remain seated in your assigned seats, unless otherwise instructed.**
The teacher dismisses the class NOT the bell.
- 7. Turn in all assignments on time as instructed. Collect graded work from the appropriate trays when instructed to do so.** Late work will not be collected **unless** the student has an excused absence for the due date or it is attached to a progress report that has been signed by a parent or guardian.
- 8. Do NOT play with water or gas faucets or any other equipment or chemicals in the lab.**
- 9. Follow laboratory protocol and rules at all times**
- 10. All rules and guidelines** regarding Attendance, Cell Phones, Student Dress Code and Conduct given in the School Board of Broward County **Student Code of Conduct Book** will be followed in this classroom
